

## To Register for Classes


1. Choose your classes. Classes will be available on a first come, first serve basis. Register early! Spaces cannot be saved without the name of a participant.
2. All Registrations will be online! Go to: **[www.sgvcbsa.org](http://www.sgvcbsa.org)**, click on Pow Wow 2011.
3. Payment may be made by credit card online with a small fee or by check sent to San Gabriel Valley Council. All registrations made after January 15th must be paid online.
4. Print a copy of your schedule and bring it with you to Pow Wow.
5. Den Chiefs must be signed in and out by an adult, and a consent to treat form must be filled out by their parents and brought to Pow Wow. *(form available online)*
6. Online registration will close on Monday, January 31, 2011.
